City of Edmonton Chief Electrical Inspector Update. Electrical Service Repairs. In alignment with the **Epcor Customer Connection Guide**, builders and their contractors are reminded that any time an electrical panel is replaced when doing a service repair the complete electrical service must align with current electrical code requirements. Repairs to the mast, changing out the main breaker, repairing a damaged cable, or similar maintenance type work where the electrical panel does not require replacing can observe existing service and does not need to be upgraded to current code. Please note round or small square meter sockets are no longer permitted.
